Psychology is the scientific study of the human mind. You will be introduced to some basic ideas from different approaches within psychology, for example, cognitive and biological approaches to the understanding of behaviour. You will explore concepts such as gender, aggression and consumer habits. You will learn how to apply psychology to real life situations and conduct your own research.

Please note: Whilst this course sits within our A Level provision and is to be taken alongside two other A Levels, the qualification you will gain at the end of the programme is a Pearson Level 3 BTEC Extended Certificate, rather than an A Level.

Why study this course?

Your course will consist of a mix of coursework and external examinations over two years. You will develop skills in critical thinking, collaborative working, self-reflection and your ability to write at an academic level. Psychology can benefit many careers, this course focuses on units that suit fields such as health and social care and the criminal justice system.

What will I study?

You will study a variety of areas, including:

- Psychological Approaches and Applications
- · Conducting research
- Health Psychology
- Psychopathology
