Some students progress onto a Higher Education course, such as the HNC / HND in Tourism Management run through the Heart of Yorkshire Education Group.

## **Entry requirements**

4 GCSEs at grade 9-4, including English and/or maths

Level 2 qualification with Merit grade, plus Level 2/grade 9-4 English and/or maths

#### Level 3 Introductory Diploma/Extended Diploma

 $5\ \mbox{GCSEs}$  at grade 9-4, including English and maths  $\mbox{OR}$ 

Level 2 qualification with Merit grade, plus Level 2/grade9-4 in English and maths

### **Assessment**

Assessments will also be varied to ensure you have every opportunity to demonstrate your knowledge. You may be assessed through practical tasks, short-answer questions, research tasks, written assignments, producing visual displays such as leaflets, observations of role-play.

Level 3 students may also undertake market research, case studies and investigations, presenting your findings in a variety of formats such as reports, brochures and presentations that you might find in working situations within the industry. Some units at all levels may be assessed by online tests.
